Issues and Conditions for applying Information Systems Master's program with thesis;

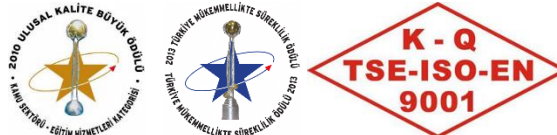
The application conditions for the other master's programs with thesis, announced on the Sakarya University Institute of Science and Technology website for student admission, will also be valid

for the Information Systems Program. Likewise, the evaluation criteria used for candidates applying to other master's programs with thesis will also be valid for the Information Systems Program. These criteria are published on the Sakarya University Institute of Science and Technology website.

All bachelor grads will be able to apply to the Information Systems Graduate Program.

Graduates from Computer, Information Systems and Software Engineering departments who will apply to the program will start without scientific preparation.

The decision regarding the scientific preparation phase of other engineering faculty graduates will be made by the head of the institute department of the program. The application evaluation and scientific preparation program of non-engineering graduate candidates will be determined by the head of the graduate school.
